Much of this research is explained in Montessori: The Science Behind the Genius, written by Angeline Stoll Lillard and published in 2005. Evidence is clearly conveyed by citing scientific studies along with descriptions of what happens in a Montessori classroom and why it works. This work substantiates that Montessori is a most effective method to address the way children naturally develop and learn.


